
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Issue: Gender-inclusive Al

To build gender-equitable AI systems it is crucial to have diverse and heterogenous AI development teams because these people are accountable for the algorithms and are responsible for the decisions the AI system makes. According to UNESCO only 12 per cent of AI developers are women. Less than 2% of employees in technical roles at Facebook and Google are black.



Little wonder then that in many applications AI is seen as biased towards white men. Joy Buolamwini, a computer scientist and founder of the Algorithmic Justice League, found that one government dataset of faces collected for testing comprised of 75% men and 80% lighter-skinned individuals and less than 5% women of color.

It is of particular importance to improve the representation and participation of women in technical roles. The initiative Women in AI, founded in 2016, is working on this mission. Have a look on their Website: https://www.womeninai.co/about-wai

AI and Ethics

The question of AI and ethics is very much in the public debate these days and there are increasing concerns about the ethical use of AI in education and training. To give but a few examples there is obviously the issue of bias when it comes to employing staff and there are growing concerns about privacy and surveillance by AI powered applications. It is also being asked how young people are able to make informed choices for the use of their data.

Although there are various call for ethics frameworks and ethics boards we really need to do practical things now. Here are a few ideas:

- All AI based applications for education should include educationalists in their design teams
- All algorithms for AI in education should be transparent
- Just as with new medicines, those developing AI based applications in education should be required to publish evaluation data about the use and efficacy of their software.
